Parent Involvement



• School Plan for Student Achievement

Mr. DiSanto shows and discusses the School Plan for Student Achievement. The school's categorical funding budget was shared and reviewed. Fundings must match the goals. This year there is a new math curriculum the was purchased in grades 3rd-5th. 6th grade used it last year and had great growth. Funding also covers

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push-in support for 3rd and 4th grade. There are 5 goals set. Goal 1: increase percentage of ALL students scoring a 3 or 4 on the SBAC in math by 5%. Goal 2: increase percentage of ALL students scoring a 3 or 4 on the SBAC in ELA by 5%. Goal 3: increase percentage of EL students scoring a 3 or 4 on the SBAC in ELA by 5%. Goal 4: Decrease chronic absentee rate by 5% year over year. Goal 5: decrease suspension rate by 2% year over year. Tom Lu asks what can be done to fix absentees? Mr. DiSanto explains the letters of concern, SBAR process, absents so far this year has been up from last year. School is trying to bring in more school incentives for attendance. Year Long perfect attendance discussed. Compared data between 2021-2023 Math and ELA SBAC data. overall behavior referrals are down this year compared to last year. Mr. DiSanto shared the Maple Creek information on the California School Dashboard site.
