## Cultural Corner

### Holocaust Remembrance Day

Holocaust Remembrance Day is held for two days every spring, in April or May. The word holocaust means a great destruction, especially by fire. During World War II six million Jews were murdered by the Nazis, this is called the Holocaust. The main ceremony is broadcast from the Holocaust Memorial in Jerusalem. A siren is sounded at 10 am. This is the beginning of two minutes of national silence and stillness. All movement comes to a stop, including cars, trains, and other forms of transportation. There are also candlelight ceremonies and displays of writings and artwork made by Holocaust victims.

In 1933, Adolf Hitler, the leader of Germany, began a plan to destroy all Jewish people. After Germany invaded Poland in 1939, France and Great Britain declared war on Germany and World War II began. The United States and other countries fighting against Germany were called the Allies.

By 1940 the Jews were put into ghettos and were forced to live in crowded rooms with no running water, heat, or electricity. Millions of Jews were then taken to concentration camps where they were starved and forced to work in inhumane conditions. Many Jews were killed in gas chambers.

In 1945 the Allies entered Germany and freed the Jews from the concentration camps. Holocaust Remembrance Day is held on the date the Jews were freed from the first concentration camp in Buchenwald, Germany in honor of the six million Jewish people killed.
