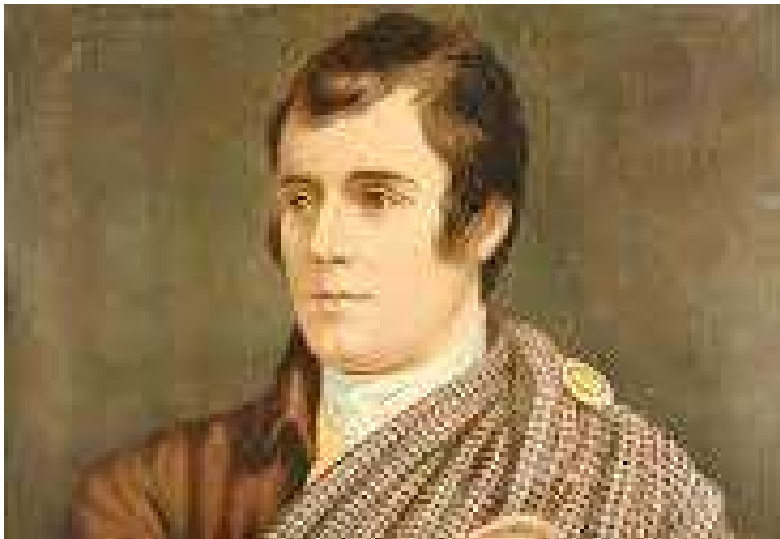

### Robbie Burns Day

Many countries honor famous leaders and others on their birthdays every year. In Scotland Robbie Burns Day is celebrated every January 25 in honor of the famous poet and writer Robert Burns, who was born on January 25, 1759. Robert Burns wrote many poems, song lyrics, and political pieces. He is probably most famous for writing the words to the song Auld Lang Syne. This is the song people sing at New Year's celebrations. Burns died at the age of 37 from heart disease. People throughout Scotland and the world celebrate Robbie Burns Day or Robbie Burns Night by eating a traditional meal and reading his poetry. The main food eaten on Robbie Burns Night is haggis. Haggis is a type of sausage that is cooked in a sheep's stomach. It is brought into the room to the sound of bagpipes playing. It is displayed on the table while someone reads the "Address to a Haggis." This is a poem that Robert Burns wrote in honor of the Scottish dish. The evening usually ends with the singing of Auld Lang Syne.
