



# **Cultural Corner**

### **Iditarod**

The Iditarod is a dog sled race that takes place every March in Alaska. The trail goes for 1150 miles from Anchorage to Nome. It begins on the first Saturday in March and usually lasts for 10 days. The word Iditarod comes from an Indian word and means "a distant place." Sled dogs pull the sled and musher across frozen rivers, barren tundra, and steep mountains. The winning musher wins a large cash prize.

The first Iditarod race was held in 1973. The dog sled race is held in memory of the "Great Race of Mercy." In 1925 a deadly disease was spreading throughout the town of Nome, Alaska. Many children were in danger of losing their lives. The only way to save them was to bring medicine 674 miles across land from the town of Nenana to Nome using dog sleds. Twenty teams of mushers and over 100 dogs ran in relays and brought the medicine to Nome in 5 ½ days. The lead dog of the team to arrive in Nome was Balto. He became very famous. There is a stature of Balto in Central Park in New York City. Many mushers feel that a musher named Leonhard Seppala and his lead dog named Togo, were the real heroes. They ran over the most dangerous parts of the route and carried the medicine farther than any other team.
