Durga Puja/Dussehra

There are many Hindu festivals in different parts of India that celebrate the victory of good over evil. They are known by different names. One of these festivals is Duraga Puja. Puja means worship in Sanskrit, an ancient Hindu language. Durga Puja is a ten-day festival celebrated in West Bengal and in other areas of India in October. The first nine nights are called Navaranti. The days are spent in prayer to Durga. Durga is a goddess who is shown as a tall woman with ten arms and riding a lion. She is the representation of energy. On the first day of Durga Puja hymns are sung and prayers are recited. This is done to try and get the attention of Durga. The sixth day is a day of fasting. There is worship and celebration during the seventh-ninth days. The tenth day celebrates Durga's triumph.
