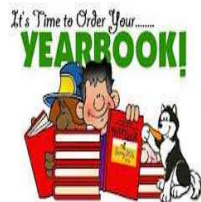
VIP and Son's BlaCkLiGhT Dance

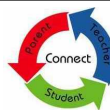

Important AR Change

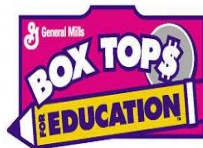

Celebrations Around The World

Columbus Day

Columbus Day is October 12th, but in the United States is observed on the second Monday in October. Christopher Columbus was an Italian explorer and navigator. In 1492, he convinced King Ferdinand and Queen Isabella of Spain to pay for his expedition to find a shorter way to the East Indies in Asia, an area where there was much trading of merchandise. He was positive that the world was round so he was going to sail West to reach the far East. He thought the journey was about 2,400 miles long. He set sail on August 3, 1492 with 3 ships the Nina, Pinta, and Santa Maria. On October 12 he finally saw land. In the United States, Columbus is celebrated because his discoveries changed the course of history.
