Drop Off, Pick Up and Traffic:

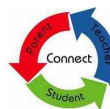
The traffic zones around our school were designated by our school district in a joint effort with the city. Please be aware of signs and painted curbs on Maple which designate drop off zones, bus zones and no parking zones. If you park and leave your vehicle during the drop off hours listed on the sign, you could be issued a ticket. If you need to park and leave your vehicle, please use the parking lots off of Teague and park in designated parking spaces. We also ask that you follow the guidance and directions given by our staff and crossing volunteers as they are working to keep our children safe and educate parents of the rules around the school

After School:

If students do not participate in an after school program they should not be on campus unless under the direct supervision of their parents. Younger siblings cannot wait for older siblings. Our after school supervision concludes at 3:15 and we have many after school programs taking place that utilize our facility. If you are on campus after school, your child should remain with you.
